Pre-Prep Sports Day

Pre-Prep Sports Day will take place on Thursday 24th June in Court Park for children in Reception and Years 1 & 2. The event will take place as a staggered year group event this year. Please note that this is a programmed school activity and all children must attend.

Children should wear their correct Sports Day kit: white polo shirt, black shorts (for Reception children only), green shorts/skorts (for Year 1/Year 2), white ankle socks, predominantly white trainers. They should also have a school sun hat and sun cream should be applied at home before school, a track-suit and a coat (green school coat for Reception and Year 1 and school rain mac for Year 2 only) depending on the weather. Girls may like to wear house ribbons in their hair. Each child will be issued with a competitor number sticker.

We very much hope that parents will be permitted to attend and we will confirm timings and arrangements next week if this is possible. We await the government announcement on Monday about public gatherings in public spaces after 21st June.

Teachers will look after and organise the children throughout the Sports Day. All Sports Day events will be taking place during normal curriculum hours so drop off and pick up times on the day will remain the same.

As Sports Day is taking place in Court Park this year it is weather dependent and unfortunately there is no reserve date.

The Sports Day programme has been adapted a little this year; however, the children will continue to compete individually for rosettes and in their house teams for the Sports Day House Cup. The children will all participate in at least one track event and six skills station activities.

We look forward to a super day of sporting endeavour and we will write to you again next week to confirm if parents will be permitted to attend.
